DESCRIPTION

Classic EZ Coat is a unique 2-part formula designed to be applied over existing concrete in order to restore it to a "like new" condition. It was originally created to go over faded, discolored, old, or new concrete to provide a uniform color without losing the texture of the surface. EZ Coat can also be used over stamped and broomed finished concrete, brick, block walls, Spanish tile, manufactured stone veneers, and paver surfaces. EZ Coat can be stained with a Classic water based stain 3 hours after application. EZ Coat must be sealed using a Classic water based sealer or a Classic approved solvent-based sealer. Be sure to follow sealer application instructions on the label and/or technical data sheet. Using a Classic sealer will enhance the color of your surface. EZ Coat is available in gray and white with 30 optional EZ Tint liquid color packs. Custom colors are also available. Add EZ Grip to combat slipperiness. EZ Coat can be used on horizontal and vertical surfaces and can be applied with a roller or an airless sprayer. Professional use only. New concrete must cure for 28 days before applying EZ Coat.

LIMITATIONS

Must be applied by a professionally licensed contractor with experience in applying EZ Coat

Clean surfaces with Classic Super Eco Etch then power wash and rinse well

No moisture and hydrostatic pressure. Do not allow EZ Coat surface to get wet before staining or sealing

Not for use on self-leveling cement, polished cement, or under water

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SURFACE PREPARATION

✓ READ SDS BEFORE HANDLING & APPLICATION

- ✓ Highly recommended to test a small inconspicuous area first.
- ✓ TURN OFF SPRINKLERS FOR TWO DAYS PRIOR TO AND AFTER.
- ✓ Always protect neighboring surfaces including wood, carpet, metal, landscaping and other non-masonry surfaces.
- ✓ Caution: Surface is slippery when wet.
- ✓ Before you start, wear rubber gloves & safety glasses.
- ✓ New concrete must cure for 28 days before application.

Prepare the surface by carefully and thoroughly removing any laitance, glue, grease, and foreign matter. For the best results, we highly recommend cleaning the surface with Classic Super Eco Etch (see instructions on Super Eco Etch label for cleaning instructions.) Depending on the hardness of the floor will determine what bond diamond to use. Patch all existing cracks from 1/8"-4" with classic cement patch gray (MPG101). Pot life is 20 minutes. Grind concrete to 60/80 diamond, but no higher than 100 grit diamond. Clean surfaces well with clean water making sure to remove all of the dust. Vacuum floor between each pass, as to not contaminate the floor with previous dust. Clean concrete surface with a walk behind floor auto scrubber and allow to dry for a minimum of 24 hours before applying EZ Coat.

NOTE: Before staining or sealing EZ Coat, do not walk on it without first cleaning your shoes. Any shoes used to walk on EZ Coat BEFORE staining or sealing must be completely clean of any dirt, dust, or debris.

HOW TO MIX

Remove one bag of EZ Coat C-Flex and one quart of primer from the box. In a clean 2 or 5 gallon pail, add one quart of primer and 3 quarts of clean water then mix for two minutes. Add the EZ Coat C-Flex bag and mix for 5-6 minutes.

When adding EZ Tint, use only 2.5 quarts of water to 1 quart of primer plus 1 bag of EZ Coat C-Flex. Mix thoroughly for 5-6 minutes or until you achieve a uniform color. For an anti-slip finish, add 1 kit of EZ Grip (color may lighten).

APPLICATION

EZ Coat must be applied over a clean dry surface. Surface temperature should be between 50-80°F. The best way to apply EZ Coat is with a 9" or 18" woven nap roller. EZ coat may also be applied using an airless sprayer (make sure to run through a paint mesh strainer first when using a sprayer). The best time for application is early in the morning when the surface temperature is between 65-75°F.) Constantly mix EZ Coat every 4 minutes when in use. Do not leave the container in direct sunlight when not in use. This product must be used within 1.5 hours after the initial mix. When mixing more than 1 EZ Coat with EZ Tint, make sure to mix them all together in order to achieve a more uniform color.

STAINING / SEALING

EZ Coat can be stained with a Classic water based stain or sealed 3 hours after application. When using a sealer, apply 2 coats of a Classic water based sealer or a Classic approved solvent-based sealer. The color of your surface can be enhanced drastically depending on the Classic sealer you choose. We highly recommend you perform a sample on an inconspicuous place of your surface to get the most accurate idea of your finished job.

Please refer to the technical data sheets of the stain or sealer selected for application instructions as each product has their own unique application techniques.
