SURFACE PREPARATION

✓ READ SDS BEFORE HANDLING & APPLICATION

- ✓ Highly recommended to test a small inconspicuous area first.
- ✓ Always protect neighboring surfaces including wood, carpet, metal, landscaping and other non-masonry surfaces.
- ✓ Clean concrete with Classic Super Eco-Etch before staining.
- ✓ Before you start staining wear rubber gloves & safety glasses
- ✓ New concrete must cure for 28 days before stain is applied.

Always clean your surfaces to remove oil, dirt, debris or any other foreign matter before applying. Stain your surface with a like color to avoid seeing the blank surface through any spots the paint chips may miss during the application process. Apply a coat of epoxy before distributing the color chips onto the surface. We recommend using our 100% Epoxy (CE500) or our Water Base Epoxy (EW2) • Epoxy is clear but color packs to match your chips are available and are highly recommended.

HOW TO MIX

When using more than one package of chips, mix them together prior to applying in order to achieve a consistent blend.

APPLICATION

Coverage will vary depending on use and thickness of your epoxy. When using more than one package of chips, mix them together prior to applying in order to achieve a consistent blend. Lightly distribute color chips over the wet epoxy on your surface. Once epoxy is dry, sweep loose color chips off and remove from your surface. Scrape the floor with a drywall scraper to remove any leftover chips. Only seal the surface with a Classic Coatings Sealer.
